- 1. Call to Order by Robert Holcomb at 3:17 pm

- 3. Debriefing of Fall 2021 Program. Robert reviewed the last season of speakers:
  - Charles Yu
    - James Blue -considerations about the Charles Yu compensation and how it was contracted. He received and disseminated the recording and the 2-week access. The WOLM committee initiated the contract and when the recording was available it was sent DL Staff all for a 2-week period.
    - There are hopes, if done again, keeping the recording a bit longer and hopefully can know that fact before we sign the contract. If a high-profile author comes up again we should look at the contract again because we had Dolores Huerta, Erika Lee, Tim Wise and other high-profile authors in the past and didn't have this type of stipulation restrictions.
    - Arts & Lectures paid \$1000 and other sources to a total of \$10,000

- 4. Review, discussion, prioritization of Spring 2022 proposals
  - One faculty member did not submit proposal, only email request and there is a suggestion to submit proposal for future semester-Fall 2022
  - One faculty member submitted 3 proposals aligning with Women's History Month
    - Stephanie Robillard-recently gave presentation (2019)-declined
    - Catherine Sanchez-accepted
    - Mary Louise Hill-accepted
      - Will these people be in a panel? Some confusion here
      - Robert suggests two dates in March and three stipends for presenters
  - Jean Hegland and Lomig (she will read a passage a passage and the illustrator will draw the scene) will the illustrator also receive a stipend?
  - James is concerned about too many presenters in a season. He advocates for fewer speakers
