

BFC SRJC Technology Bond Spending Update October 4, 2016

- Starting process to update SRJC Technology (3-year update cycle)
- Starting review and re-justification of Measure H technology spending plan

Smartnet - \$127K- board consent approval item. This is the annual support cost for CISCO network service support and software updates on our over \$5M in CISCO network infrastructure. This is paid from the unrestricted general fund since annual software and support expenses are not bond eligible.

Emergency Phones in Classrooms - We will be adding phones to all classes in Emeritus in two phases, phase 1 this fall 18 classrooms \$13.5K and phase 2 in the spring 13 classrooms \$11.5K, total \$25K. The team is working on a plan for Petaluma and all classrooms to be phased in over the next 2-3 years.

RFP for Consultant to assist in SIS RFP - A statement of work was created and an RFP launched to hire a consultant to guide the RFP process for a new SIS. SIS replacement RFP process will be done over the spring semester.

Demonstration Classrooms - Additional technology features that were not ready by PDA day are being installed in the 8 classrooms in October and November as phase 2 of this project. A second round of feedback surveys will inform the classroom refresh cycle planned for summer 2017. Phase 2 includes continued simplification and redesign of the audio-visual controls in the room and introduction of tablet touchscreens so that faculty no longer have to switch their instructor computer back and forth between presentation content and room control systems. Additional training on ways to integrate new wireless presentation tools into dynamic instruction and planned upgrades to quality projection will also occur.
