- Review Facilities & Bond Projects: Cindy  
Review of bond projects—does this pertain to DAC. Does pertain to ADA and projects? See above.
- Status update - Web Accessibility Policy/Procedure 2.17P/P: Leila  
District Board Policy and Procedure 2.17 is scheduled to be reviewed by College Council on February 8. The committee discussed that all employees should be mindful of accessibility in all areas, especially online sites. Next steps will be to determine vetting of the policy.
  - ✓ Committee discussed whether Distance Education should review 2.17 P/P.
  - ✓ Action: 2.17 P/P will replace 3.12.3 P/P (developed by Phyllis Usina).
- Digital Accessibility/ADA Compliant Signage: n/a
- Update on Maps: Cindy  
Reviewed other college sites to confirm status of maps and she understands that SRJC desires functional maps. Cindy has been unable to find the original drawings of maps and this has been a slow going process. Karen indicated that Erin Bricker of Public Relations presented at a Cabinet meeting to demonstrate PR's new website (to include drop down menus of campus maps). Currently, Mike Garcia of PR is the point person for updating maps.
- Digital Accessibility Emergency Communications: Robin  
Suggested dates for emergency alert test drills are being discussed with Cabinet. The District is considering changing alert system from Regroup to Informacast. IT infrastructure is still pending.
- Quinn Locker Room rooms: Cindy/Karen:  
Grab bars will be installed by Facilities Staff

- One-way street at Scholars Drive – Kathy  
One-way street may be pending due to SRT still being housed near the tennis courts while Burbank remodel is completed. However, the City of Santa Rosa Board of Directors has approved SRJC's request to use City of Santa Rosa tennis courts space temporarily.
- Proposal for DAC Funding for a blind student worker to work on accessibility projects – Corinne/Leila  
Corinne and Leila provided an update regarding students hired to work on accessibility projects.
- Portal and website portal design: Don Webb  
Leila updated the committee stating that the ad-hoc committee approved the homepage redesign. New web design should go live in June 2019. Conversations are continuing regarding portal design.
