## **Adoption of Minutes:**

## Cases:

- 1) Adaptive PE case needs to be better documented. The candidate needs to show how their education is equivalent to a Bachelor's in one of the listed topics, such as KAD. The Department Chair needs to outline the specific training the candidate possesses that meets minimum quals.
- 2) The Social Media request in wine studies is not appropriate for the committee to review. The applicant already is teaching Social Media through CSI. There is no way to grant equivalency for this candidate in agriculture as the minimum qualifications are completely different. If the department wishes to offer a class in Social Media with an emphasis on wine studies, then they should work with the CSI department to cross-list the course.

## **Discussion of Items**

- The committee discussed with Eric Thompson (Senate President) which version of Procedure 4.3.2bP will be shopped to constituent groups. It was agreed that revised version from our last meeting made the most sense and once all corrections have been made we can send the document back to the Senate (the originating body).
