Legislative Updates: ABs 705, 1018, 504, 19

- AB705 PowerPoint
 - To increase student to get through our system and in the second semester to be in college level English and Math
 - One semester remedial classes and this is the letter of the law-this will be the change of the spirit on our State and will cause a shift of English and Math
 - Carlos wants to make sure that we all understand this and the BSI formula encapsulates how we do remediation
 - o How are we doing with our equity gaps so we know the students are successful?
 - Matthew Long says another state (Connecticut) had these issues and had good results
 - Future of standardized tests using GPA from HS and 90 percent will go into transfer level
 - Talk of a 'stretch model' course option where students move through remedial course together, or as a cohort
- AB504
 - Equity gaps

- Percentage point gap
- AB1018
 - Adding new categories for equity target population- homeless, LGBT
- AB19 -California Promise- first time, full time students can have fees waived

2016-2017 Equity Evaluations

- Linked to target populations
- Scalable
- Clear evaluation plan
- Demonstrate success
 - o Logic models-shifting from old to new evaluation format
- Teams Report out
 - o How to provide assessment in a 2-3 year cycle?
 - Equity program evolving the evaluation process. Desire to remove some of the assumptions, more clearly define evaluation framework and allow time to provide more discussion and feedback when looking at Red, Yellow, Green lights (High, Medium and Low scoring Equity Projects)
 - o The next steps, what do we want to see?
 - The Equity department to work with OIR on a new template
 - Talk about communication/feedback around Red, Yellow, Green projects and propose something to the committee?
 - Possibly form a subcommittee to work on this?
