- Develop strategies and presentations for keeping faculty informed of best practices and changing technologies for providing textbooks and/or instructional materials to students.
- 5. Support and inform faculty on adoption and review of accessible Open Educational Resources (OER).

The constituent make-up of the committee will reflect the diverse textbook <u>and instructional materials</u> needs of all academic departments' students.

The bookstore director (or related position as determined by the District and/or contracted entity) is a key constituent and will participate as an Ex-Officio member.
