Develop an understanding of the various ways donors can support the Santa Rosa Junior College Petaluma Campus.
- 3) Participate in community events sponsored by the Friends of Petaluma Trust via planning, execution and attendance.
- 4) Provide leadership toward meeting the fund development goals of the Friends of Petaluma Trust.
- 5) Provide community visibility for the Santa Rosa Junior College Petaluma Campus' programs and services.
- 6) Be an active member by attending the Friends of Petaluma Trust meetings and committing to serve on at least one sub-group per year formed to accomplish annual Friends of Petaluma Campus Trust goals.
- 7) Attend the Friends of Petaluma Campus Trust Annual Retreat (approximately 4 hours).
- 8) Make a personal or corporate/company gift of \$500 or more annually to the Friends of Petaluma Campus Trust.
- 9) Support the work of the Santa Rosa Junior College Foundation.
- 10) Commit to an initial three-year term and annual renewals thereafter.
